



# Truro & District Motor Club Cornwall Coast to Coast Tour Sunday 15 May 2016



## Supplementary Regulations

1. Truro & District Motor Club Ltd will organise a classic and sports car Touring Assembly on Sunday 15 May.

The tour will start at Atlantic Café, Portreath Beach, TR16 4NN, lunch will be at Roskilly's Ice Cream Farm, St Keverne, Helston TR12 6NX and it will finish with a cream tea at The Cove Restaurant, Maenporth Beach, Falmouth, TR11 5HN. The route is approximately 85 miles.

2. The event will be held under the General Regulations of the Motor Sports Association (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA) these Supplementary Regulations and any further written instructions issued by the organising club.

3. MSA Certificate of Exemption number 93410 has been issued.

4. The event is open to Truro & District Motor Club members and non-members. You do not need to be a club member to enter. Competition licences are not required.

5. The event is open to all classic cars registered before 31 Dec 1985 and modern sports cars, kit cars and other interesting cars at the discretion of the organisers. Half the entries will be reserved for classic cars and the remaining half will be allocated on a first come first served basis, subject to acceptance by the organisers.

Any change of car must be notified in writing (or by email), stating make, model and age. Any change of car is subject to acceptance by the organisers.

All cars must meet the legal requirements to run on public roads in Great Britain. By entering the event you confirm that you have valid insurance, MOT and road tax. The use of trade plates is not permitted. Vehicle checks will be carried out at the start (lights, wipers, tyres etc).

6.     Signing on from 08.30 at Atlantic Café  
       Briefing at 09.15  
       Start 09.30 with cars starting at one minute intervals  
       There will be a coffee break at approx.11.00  
       Lunch at Roskilly's from 12.30  
       Restart 14.00  
       Finish at The Cove at about 16.00.

7. A road book will be provided at signing-on. This contains tulip route instructions to enable you to follow the route (for example a T with an arrow pointing left or right to show which way to go at a T junction). There are no penalties for deviating from the suggested route.

Not all junctions will appear in the road book, in which case you stay on the main road. The distance between the tulips will be given. You may find it useful to bring a road map in case you lose your way. Please contact us if you would like further information about tulip route instructions.

8. A traditional style rigid rally plate will be provided at signing-on and should be fixed to the front of your car. Please bring some string or cable ties.

9. Penalties: The penalty for any of the following may result in exclusion: 1) any breach of these regulations. 2) a car found to be ineligible. 3) breach of any traffic law. 4) prejudicial behaviour.

10. Finish: To qualify as a finisher, a participant must: 1) arrive at the finish before the check point closes 2) not incur a penalty of exclusion.

11. Awards will be given at the discretion of the organisers for best looking/well prepared cars. Each entrant will also be given a voting slip to vote for their favourite car overall. Finishers commemorative awards may also be given.

13. Entries open on publication of these regulations and close on Saturday 7 May. All entries must be made on the official entry form, accompanied by the entry fee of £37.50 per car (£35 for TDMC members) plus any extra payment for food/drinks and sent to the Secretary before the closing date. The entry form is available on the TDMC website or by contacting the organisers.

The minimum number of entries is 15 and the maximum 50. Should the minimum number not be received then the organisers have the right to cancel the event.

Entries will be acknowledged by email. Final instructions will be emailed by Thursday 12 May. If the event has to be cancelled notification will also be sent by email. Please check your email regularly. If you do not have access to an email address, please include a stamped addressed envelope with your entry form.

Refreshments and food will be available at the start, morning break, lunch and finish venues. It is not obligatory to pre-order but if you don't we cannot guarantee there will be food available as the venues get very busy. Please select your requirements on the entry form. The entry fee includes tea/coffee at the start and at the mid-morning break and cream teas at the finish for two people per car only. You can order for extra people on the entry form.

12. If the event is postponed/cancelled, the organisers will refund any entry fees paid. However, if the event is cancelled due to circumstances beyond our control we will not refund entry fees.

If you cancel your entry prior to the closing date we will refund 100% of your fee. If you cancel prior to Wednesday 11 May we will refund 50% of your fee. No shows or cancellations after this date will not be refunded.
