FOREWORD

In 1922 Donald and his brother Geoffrey Healey, ran the first TDMC event by closing off a section of road between Truro and Perranporth to run a sprint. The Police turning a blind eye to the closed road. They were also the first ones to use what is now the tarmac road at Blue Hills for a trial.

To celebrate the Club's centenary, we are running the Centenary Classic Tour, an event for classic cars starting and finishing at Healey's Cyder Farm. The road run will be approximately 80-90 miles with lunch at Trebah the home of Donald Healey.

Entrants will be supplied with a tulip type road book enabling them to navigate the route with ease. The first car will start at 10:00am with the remaining starting a one-minute intervals, each entrant who finishes will get a pair of finishers awards on arrival back at Healey's Cyder Farm where the first car is expected at about 17:30.

There will be an award for the best car in the event chosen by you the competitor and possibly other awards.

The Club will be hosting a post classic run buffet event at Healey's from 18:00hrs. There will some guests and the Healey family's vehicles on display. The evening celebration is a '**ticket only**' event open to Centenary Tour entrants and TDMC members old and new. Healey's are also creating a TDMC special cyder for the event and thanks must go to Healey's Cyder Farm for their help with this event and supplying the evening buffet at cost price.

The Club are very happy to welcome on board Bob Pepper and Frame Homes who have kindly sponsored this and other Truro Motor Club events for 2022.

Thanks, must also go to Castrol for their help and permission in allowing the club to reproduce the old 50/60's 'poster' depicting an Austin Healey 100/4 at 142.6mph. The 'poster' recreated in aluminium will be on sale at club events.

Event Regulations

1. EVENT ORGANISATION AND DESCRIPTION

- 1.1 The event will be organised by the Truro & District Motor Club Ltd. (the "Organiser").
- 1.2 The event is a Touring Assembly; it is not a Competition. A Motorsport UK Certificate of Exemption has been issued for the event, CofE Number 120774.
- 1.3 These Regulations and any additional instructions, including any bulletins issued by the event, will be deemed to be an appendix to and have the same powers as these Regulations.
- 1.4 The provisional route, which may be subject to amendment, will Start and Finish at the Healey's Cyder Farm, Penhallow, Truro, on **Sunday 26th June 2022**. The Touring Assembly will immediately be followed by an evening buffet and social for current and old club members, and Centenary entrants (see entry form).

2. ELIGIBLE CARS AND PARTICIPANTS

- 2.1 The event is open to three and four-wheeled road cars, including replica cars manufactured before 1st January 2003. We may also accept entries for later model vehicles which the Organiser considers 'interesting' or of 'special interest'.
- 2.2 All cars must meet the legal requirements to run on the public roads in the UK. The use of trade plates is not permitted.
- 2.3 No advertising, trade sign, or previous event standard size rally plates or decals may be displayed on the vehicle, except those issued by the organisers. No promotional material shall be distributed from any vehicle unless prior arrangements have been agreed with the Organiser.
- 2.4 The event is open to all members holding a full valid driving licence. A competition licence is not required.
- 2.5 Pets may not be carried in cars.

3. ENTRIES

- 3.1 Entries open on **1st May 2022** and close on **Sunday 19th June 2022**. Entries may be accepted after this date, at the Organiser's discretion, assuming spaces are available.
- 3.2 The total entry fee for a car plus 2 persons will be **£65 per car**. This fee will include two Tea/coffees at the mid-morning stop, two, two course Sunday lunches, two cream teas mid-afternoon, Centenary Tour rally plates, two finishers' awards and of course your entry.

You can guarantee your entry by completing the online entry form available from the Truro & District Motor Club web site. On completing the form, the process will take your entry fee automatically by either credit or debit card.

Should you have any problems with the Clubs simple entry process then please contact the Secretary of the Meeting direct for assistance.

3.3 The maximum number of entries that will be accepted is 50, the minimum will be 20. Should the minimum figure not be reached the organisers reserve the right to cancel the event. Should the event be cancelled, the Organiser will refund any entry fees paid (see paragraph 6).

3.4 Any change of vehicle must be notified in writing (an email is acceptable), stating make, model and age of the vehicle to the organisers. Any changes of vehicle received after the closing date may not appear in the entry list. The replacement vehicle must comply with Article 2.1 or a vehicle which is acceptable by the Organiser under Article 2.1.

3.5 Participants will be provided with a numbered rally plate, which must be displayed in a forward-facing position at the front of the vehicle. No other numbers must be displayed other than the vehicle registration number plate. The 'Rally Plate' must be visible to officials to be able to gain access to any reserved parking locations.

3.6 Participants will receive a detailed Route Book before the event, together with a documentation card which should be completed and handed in at the event finish control.

4. DOCUMENTATION

4.1 Participants will be required to 'sign on' at Healey's Start, the declaration will confirm that they have valid vehicle insurance in accordance with the Road Traffic Act and that they understand the limitations of their own insurance when driving at motor sport venues if made available. Vehicle eligibility checks will be carried out at the start venue.

4.2 Cars will start at intervals of approximately 1 minute. Starting times will be provided with the Route Book.

5. CHECK POINTS

5.1 The Route will include a number of check points which will be open for a specified period. The opening and closing times will be given in the Route Book. The provisional list of Check Points are:

Start	Healey's Cyder Farm
CP1	Tremenheer Sculpture Garden Marazion
CP2	Lunch Halt – Trebah Gardens home of Donald Healey
CP3	Truro City centre
CP4	Tregrehan Hill Climb
CP5	Afternoon Tea Halt – Victoria Inn
Finish	Healey's Cyder Farm

5.2. There will be **no** competitive element.

5.3 While there is no timing element on the event, check points will be open for a set period as detailed in the Road Book. Participants arriving at a check point outside its closure time may not receive any facilities we have arranged at that location.

6. POSTPONEMENT OR CANCELLATION

6.1 The Organiser reserves the right to cancel or postpone the event should circumstance arise which cause such action to be desirable or necessary.

In these circumstances you will be entitled to receive a full refund of any money paid, excepting the case of Force Majeure as defined below. Force Majeure means any event which we could not, even with all due care, foresee or avoid. Such events include, but are not limited to, war or threat of war, riot, civil strife and terrorist activity or threat of terrorist activity, industrial dispute, natural or nuclear disaster, adverse weather conditions, fire and all similar events and circumstances outside of our control. In this case a partial refund may be given.

6.2 Should an entrant wish to withdraw from the event once the entry has been accepted, the following schedule will apply:

- i. Entry withdrawn before **19th June 2022**: Full refund of money paid less £10
- ii. After **19th June 2022**: No refund.

6.3 Any withdrawal of entry must be made in writing (an email is acceptable).

7. BEHAVIOUR AND DRIVING STANDARDS

7.1 You, the driver/entrant must comply with all UK law and driving regulations whilst participating in the event. Without limitation these include speed limits, vehicle condition, insurance, MOT, Road Fund Licences and driving under the influence of intoxicating substances.

7.2 You are solely responsible for your behaviour and agree to indemnify the organiser in full against any attempt by any third parties to bring about a claim as a direct result of any breach by you of any laws or regulations during your participation in the event.

8. LIABILITY

8.1 In entering the event, you do so completely voluntarily and with the knowledge that, if as a direct result of your actions, you or any member of your party have any accident, injury or other incident, it is entirely your responsibility and you hereby indemnify the Organiser in full against any claim brought about by you, a member of your party or a third party.
